The RC10 has proven itself to be the car to beat for the last 11 years. It won the first ever IFMAR 1:10 Off Road World Championship title in 1984-85, as well as four of the five IFMAR 1:10 Off Road World Championships ever held.

The Associated Stealth Transmission's contribution to the success of the RC10 is shown by the fact that three of the four IFMAR 1:10 Off Road World Championship titles, held by the RC10, have been won using the Stealth Transmission.

The RC10 during its eleven years was updated through various models and has compiled the most successful win record in our hobby.



To improve rough track performance and handling, the front and rear suspension travel was increased and front shocks lengthened. This new suspension geometry gives you more on-power steering. The B2 Stealth transmission is a new design that incorporates a larger 2.4:1 differential, which increases the torque handling capacity of the diff and lengthens time between rebuilds. We created a new lightweight rear shock strut to improve strength and rigidity. We have developed a new universal axle design, using a smaller 3/16" diameter axle shaft. This reduces the weight and rotating mass of the drive train and allows us to use a new, larger, ball bearing in the hub carriers to improve bearing life. The new rear suspension arms allow you to change the wheel base length for different steering and traction characteristics. Of course, our race-proven, hard anodized, PTFE coated shocks and PTFE shock pistons are included.
